The Miracle League of Greater New Orleans is gearing up for its second annual Franky & Johnny's/Zeke's Restaurant Golf Tournament. We hope we can count on your support to help make this tournament the most successful yet by playing in the tournament or donating a prize and/or food. All donations will help continue a baseball league that is dedicated to children with disabilities.

Your support will help a program that promotes the health and well-being of local children with disabilities, provide opportunities for area able-bodied children to learn about and interact with children with disabilities, and develop community awareness and support for the child athlete with disabilities through organized league baseball.

The Miracle League has a specially constructed baseball field that uses a cushioned, synthetic turf to accommodate wheelchairs and other walking-assistance devices that, along with appropriate support facilities, is designed specifically for use by children with disabilities. There are currently very few athletic opportunities for children with disabilities in the New Orleans area, and the Miracle Field is the first of its kind in southeastern Louisiana. We currently have over 250 players playing baseball and for the first time we offered soccer, in which over 70 children participated.

Through the Miracle League, many area children with disabilities will get their first opportunity to play organized ball and reap the emotional and physical benefits of being part of an athletic team. We hope this is a program you will find worthy of investing.
